Regular Meeting Minutes

July 7, 2026

- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Chairman Engelbert delivered the Sunshine Notice and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- II. **Roll Call:** Chairman Barry Engelbert - Present

- III. **Treasurer's Report** – Commissioner Rinaldi read the Treasurer's report and the submission of bills for the month of **July 2026** in the amount of **\$102,872.04**, seconded by Commissioner Lloyd
Roll Call: 4-0 Motion Carried – Commissioner Sprinitis was absent
- IV. **Minutes** - A motion to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes for the month of **June 2026** was made by Commissioner Davidson, seconded by Commissioner Rinaldi
Roll Call: 4-0 Motion carried – Commissioner Sprinitis was absent
- V. **Clerk's Report** – None at this time
- VI. **Career Report** – Fire Fighter Fowler stated that as of right now all of our Fire Trucks are down except for the rental Fire Truck. Campbell's was here and said that the transmission module is bad and that they are going to come back and try to fix it on the ladder truck. Chairman Engelbert stated that all the parts are in for the other truck to be fixed and is scheduled to be taken in for the repairs on August 3. Fire Fighter Fowler said that Campbell's did come out and fixed all the repairs that needed to be done on the engine. The pickup truck had the exhaust repaired and we only use this truck as a plow and to do odd jobs.
- VII. **Fire Marshall's Report** – Fire Marshall Schwegel stated that there is a meeting scheduled for the week of the 20th for a joint effort with the other districts for Fire Prevention. District 2 has offered their inspector students to

assist in Fire Marshall investigations.

VIII. Chief's Report – Chief Spross reported that there were a total of 77 monthly response calls for June 2026 of which A Shift had 20 calls, B Shift had 25 calls, C Shift had 25 calls and D Shift had 7 calls. Also, crews responded to 12 boxes of which 5 were working calls. There are a total of 492 year to date calls of which A Shift had 152 calls, B Shift had 148 calls, C Shift had 135 calls and D Shift had 57 calls. The Quint 85 is OOS due to a crack in the platform of the aerial ladder. Received an email from Fire and Safety which stated that all parts are in and they will be starting fabrication of the repairs in the coming weeks. The Quint 85 is scheduled to be repaired on August 3, 2026. Ladder 85 is now in service. Squad 85 is OOS and it is believed that we have a bad turbo speed sensor. Campbell's came out and will be sending a crew this week hopefully and they will need to look at it further. Fire District #3 has been nice enough to loan us Engine 83 and members will be running it as Engine 85. There is no new membership this month. An AFG Grant was submitted to FEMA. This is for funds to replace all sets of turnout gear. This will be providing a spare set for all Full Time Employees and a new set for all members. We have asked for a total of \$152,840.00 of which we will be responsible for \$7,278.00 if we are awarded. This would be for 20 complete sets of Turnout gear, boots, hoods, and gloves and 12 new helmets. The Radio grant with the rest of the district has been submitted. For the Cost Recovery we submitted 1 claim for the month of May. Cost Recovery has processed 2 claims for \$1,031.94. Year-To-Date we have submitted 9 claims for \$9,953.58. We received one payment so far.

IX. President's Report – None at this time

X. Commissioner's Report – Commissioner Rinaldi stated that the weather is hot right now and to stay hydrated. Commissioner Lloyd and Commissioner Davidson did not have any comments at this time

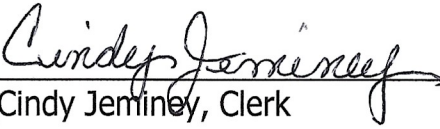
XI. Public Portion – None at this time
